- TMT: positive







### Take Home Messages

- The angiogram is frequently misleading and QCA is no longer the gold standard for lesion severity, especially in intermediate lesions.
- FFR is presently the optimal method to decide if intervention is needed in intermediate lesions and in complicated lesions even though it can not explain the reason of the complication
- IVUS contributes greatly to achieving technically an optimal PCI and can show PCI complications
